AMMI Canada – CACMID Annual Conference: Toronto – Sheraton Centre, May 3- 6

May 2, 2017 – Toronto – Over 500 leading experts in the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of infections are meeting later this week in Toronto as part of the AMMI Canada – CACMID annual conference. This is the twelfth consecutive year the two professional associations have partnered to share their members’ knowledge in the fields of microbiology, infectious diseases, infection prevention and control, antimicrobial utilization and public health.

The keynote speaker this year is Dr. Sabra Klein, PhD from Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, Maryland on May 4. She will be sharing her work on sex differences in immune responses and susceptibility to infection. Earlier that day, three experts will address concerns around resurgent infectious diseases specifically measles and mumps, Zika virus and other arboviruses.

Other topics of interest at this year’s annual conference include Novel Technologies in Microbiology, Antimicrobial susceptibility testing and therapy in the era of increasing resistance, Hepatitis C Virus Care and What’s Hot in Quality Improvement, Adult and Paediatric Infectious Diseases.
