



### Student / Technologist / Trainee Awards Competition Form

Awards will be presented to the six best poster presentations, and one best student oral presentation, by students/trainees attending and presenting at the annual conference.

**Each of the following awards consists of \$800 and an engraved plaque:**

- Association of Medical Microbiology and Infectious Disease (AMMI) Canada Poster Award
- Canadian Association for Clinical Microbiology and Infectious Diseases (CACMID) Poster Award
- Canadian Association for Clinical Microbiology and Infectious Diseases (CACMID) Student Oral Presentation Award
- Canadian Association for Clinical Microbiology and Infectious Diseases (CACMID) Technologist Poster Award
- Canadian College of Microbiologists (CCM) Poster Award
- Canadian College of Microbiologists (CCM) Dr. Kenneth Rozee Memorial Poster Award

**The following award consists of \$500 and an engraved plaque:**

- Dr. Susan King Paediatric Abstract Award (trainees, paediatric topics only)

#### Eligibility

Individual students, residents and fellows are eligible for one award. Students/trainees must be in training or have completed their training less than nine (9) months before the annual conference. Candidates are required to have significantly contributed to the investigation and to present the work. Work relevant to all aspects of microbiology and infectious diseases will be considered for poster OR oral presentation.

**N.B.** Only one prize will be awarded per student/trainee. The student/trainee must be the first author of the abstract and present as scheduled (poster presentations for judging on Thursday; oral presentations on Thursday or Friday).

**N.B.** Only one abstract per student/trainee may be submitted for the competition.

**N.B.** Applicants to the CACMID Technologist Poster Award must be current CACMID members.

**N.B.** In order to be considered for oral presentation award, the presenter must be a student/technologist or trainee.

**N.B.** The Abstract Committee reserves the right to select the final presentation format in order to meet the needs of conference planning.

**Awards presentations will take place Saturday, April 6, 2019.**
